**DIRECTIONS FROM RESURRECTION CEMETERY TO THE HERSHEY ITALIAN LODGE**

Turn LEFT out of the cemetery onto S. Oak Grove Road. Proceed straight to ALLENTOWN BOULEVARD/US 22. Turn RIGHT onto Allentown Boulevard and then RIGHT onto South Hershey Road PA-39. Continue straight until PARK BOULEVARD. Turn RIGHT onto MILL ROAD and then right onto W Chocolate Avenue/US 422. Turn Left onto NORTH ORCHARD ROAD and then RIGHT onto WEST CARACAS AVENUE. West Caracas Avenue becomes HILLCREST ROAD. Hershey Italian Lodge is located at 128 Hillcrest Road.

**DIRECTIONS FROM PRINCE OF PEACE TO THE HERSHEY ITALIAN LODGE**

Turn left onto FRONT STREET. Continue straight to EISENHOWER BOULEVARD and TURN LEFT. TURN RIGHT and Follow 283 East, take ramp to 283 NORTH. Merge onto US-322 E via Exit 3C towards Hershey. Merge onto US-422 East. Turn right onto HILLCREST ROAD and then turn RIGHT to stay on HILLCREST ROAD. Hershey Italian Lodge is located at 128 Hillcrest Road.
